### Community Involvement Commissioner: Kim Haussler

  - They will give \$1000 for the top 3 schools that bring in the most money and it enters us in a drawing
  - o They will also give us 20% of sales

#### Family Life Commissioner: Amy Dimick

- Still don't have room parents for 2 classes:

  - Amy has been sending emails to the room parents and given them the contact information that has been shared by parents
  - Some people didn't want to be room parents because of the auction baskets so we're looking for ways to do baskets by grades next year
- Michelle will do the meals for teachers
  - Back to school lunch got some negative feedback about cross contamination
  - We do have gluten free (3) and vegetarian (1) needs
  - o Probably have it boxed separately there are boxes in the lunchroom we can use
  - Cherie will send an email to the staff to check on dietary needs
  - We ran out of food in the spring for the teacher lunch so we'll make sure to add more food - teaches and staff that stays (55-60 people)
- We wanted to do a thank you for Harvest and Stretch Lab because their donations were so big
  - We will send thank yous and put their logos on a sign
- Halloween parties Amy will email everyone about parties at the beginning of October.
  Halloween is the day we get back from fall break

### Education Commissioner: Heather Belcher

- Kimber Probst: Wellness room it's a great resource
  - Could there be areas at the school activities with sensory things for kids who need it? Families may not be coming to activities because their kids may not do well.

- We can't pay for the aid to run the wellness room after school hours
- Maybe the teachers can recommend the wellness room to parents?
- We keep record of who is in there to watch for trends and what kids need
- Parents are being told if their child is in the wellness room if they are using it frequently SPED team meets every week to talk about children using the room so they can create resources for them
- All classes toured the wellness room
- There's a high number of anxiety and depression among the kids
- Make sure we're including handouts in Spanish
  - If you use Chrome, it can translate websites to another language
    - The PTA website can now be translated into Spanish, Portuguese, and Chinese by clicking on the drop down language flag in the top right corner.
  - There's a tool on Google docs to translate documents into Spanish
- Stacey Harnois: Battle of the Books
  - 25 new lanyards were made over the last 2 weeks these are for kids who signed up and read at least one book
  - o Kids seem excited and are asking how to sign up. Numbers are going up.
- We need help setting up for the Book Fair Sep 30th at 1:15pm (3)

  - We need help to run registers, but this isn't PTA run so anyone can help
